RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE

- Students are required to be punctual at the stated hours for the classes.
- Class Timings Monday to Friday 9.25 a.m. to 4.30 p.m, Lunch break 12.30 p.m. to 1.30 p.m. Saturday 9.25 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
- 75% classroom attendance is compulsory in each subject to enable students to take up the Semester/Annual Examination. If the student fails to maintain the attendance, he/she shall repeat the whole semester / year.
- 3. Students can avail sick leave for three or more days only on medical grounds and this is to be informed to the Principal at the earliest which has to be certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner authorised by the Government.
- Habitual late coming, irregular attendance for more than a day without intimation, prior permission or proper reason and avoiding internal tests will be viewed seriously.
- Incase of missing the class without the permission of the concerned Lecturer/Principal, action will be taken accordingly.
- 6. In case a student discontinues his/her studies, he/she shall pay the fees for the entire course of study.
- 7. Discourtesy towards lecturers/staff in word or act, irregular attendance, neglect of work, gross in subordination, misbehaviour within the college premises or outside etc, will be regarded as sufficient reason for punishment by the Principal, which even may be suspension or dismissal.
- Smoking and consuming alcohol/drugs in the college premises is prohibited.
- 9. Students should not take part in any agitation, political or other wise directed against the authority of the government or the college. They are also forbidden to engage prominently in any public movement without the permission of the Principal.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- 11. Students are informed not to bring their friends employed or studying in other institutions inside the college campus.
- Students must wear the college uniform and identity card on all working days & during exams.

- Students are not allowed to bring four wheelers inside the Campus.
- 14. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing Mobile Phones to the college. If any student is found bringing the mobile to the college strict disciplinary action will be taken, the mobile will be seized and fine will be imposed.
- SC/ST students can avail the reservation seats, scholarships & concession.
- Students are expected to take part in all extra curricular, and co-curricular activities.
- 17. College will take serious note of any misbehaviour even outside the premises of the college. The college expects all the students to be good ambassadors of the college.
- 18. Students who are not living with their parents are required to reside with relatives or in hostels approved by the Principal.
- Students having no classes shall not loiter in the veranda but are expected to spend time in the library; Students are not permitted to go to other classes without the Academic Advisor's permission.
- Each class has an Academic Advisor who keeps a close watch on the students attendance, progress and conduct.
- 21. College office remains open for any transaction between 9 a.m. 5.00 p.m. on all week days and between 9 a.m to 3 p.m on Saturdays. Application for Transfer/Conduct/Bonafide certificate etc should be given in the prescribed form available in the office atleast two days in advance with prescribed fees.
- 22. Students should not write, scratch on walls, desks or tables and damage the college property. If they are found indulging in such activities action will be taken.
- 23. Students should compulsorily be present on the first day of the college (each term) and on important occasions such as Student Council Inauguration, Sports day, College day. Failure to attend, fine will be imposed.
- 24. Leave note should be submitted to the concerned Class Teacher and there after to the concerned subject teacher on every hour/ day's absence. Leave note should be signed by the parent/ guardian compulsorily.
- 25. Students who take part in various EC/CC activities should maintain a record of it in the space allotted in the diary and get signed by the concerned co-ordinator immediately.

FEE REGULATION

Fee should be paid on or before the last date prescribed by the Principal. Thereafter a defaulter is liable to pay fine, in addition to the fees, as decided by the Principal. If the term's fee is not paid on the last date prescribed, the defaulter's name will be striked off from the College rolls. If admitted thereafter, he shall pay a) the Re-Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. lees along with fine and b) the re-admission fees of Rs.500

- a) No candidate shall be declared to have passed the First year/
 Second year / Third year Examination as the case may be
 under Group I & Group II unless he / she obtains not less
 than 35% marks (B.Com / BHS) and 50% (B.ASLP) in the
 aggregate of written examination and internal assessment put
 together in each of the languages / optionals subjects.
- In case a candidate fails either in Theory or Practicals, he has to appear for theory or practicals of the failed subjects at any subsequent examination and must obtain minimum pass mark in that subject (theory and practical separately).

Successful candidate shall be placed in First class, Second Class or Third class, as the case may be, in Group II (Optionals) at the end of the third year of the course. For group I (Languages), first year and the second year examinations shall be taken into considerations for this purpose.

For declaring the overall First, Second or Third class as the case may be, for Group II (optionals) at the end of the Third year of the course, the marks obtained by the candidate in group II, (optional) in the Third year or the aggregate of the marks obtained by the candidate at the first year, second year and third year examinations together, whichever is advantageous to the candidate, shall be taken into consideration.

Examination & Carry Over

No candidate shall be declared to have passed the semester examination unless he / she obtains not less than 35% marks (50% incase of B.ASLP) in written examination and 35% marks (50% incase of B.ASLP) in the aggregate of written examination and internal assessment put together in each of the subjects, 35% marks (50% incase of B.ASLP) in Project work & Viva wherever prescribed.

The internal assessment marks are based on College exam/ Tests / Assignments / Presentation / Project work.

No. of attempts allowed:

The maximum period for completing a course shall be double the duration stipulated for the programme reckoned from the year of admissions (including the year of admission) to the course.
