

PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT

A. EVALUATION:

The performance assessment of each student in every course is broadly categorized under the heading Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) conducted at college level and Examination conducted at the end of each semester at the University level.

1. Continuous Internal Assessment

- a) The internal assessment marks for each theory paper shall be based on:
 - i) One assignment / problem-solving / project / seminar etc.
 - ii) Unit tests
 - iii) Internal examinations conducted in University examination question paper pattern
 - iii) Overall performance in the class

- b) The internal assessment marks for Practicals shall be based on
 - 1) Continuous assessment of practical, practical record, practical test, progress and regularity of project work.
 - 2) Maintenance of practical records
 - 3) Practical examinations like viva voce

- c) The marks of the internal assessment shall be shown to the students prior to collection of hall tickets

- d) Minimum internal marks will be in accordance with the criteria stipulated for each course.

- e) Subject practicum assessment will be conducted at college level along with internal examination which will be marked according to their practical skills in that particular subject.

- f) In case of students who have been absent for any paper in mid-sem examination, she can take up that examination if permitted by the Principal, within the semester as notified by the college on payment of prescribed fee.

2. University Examinations:

Odd and even semester examinations will be conducted as per the Mangalore University Calendar.

3. Registration for examinations and Conduct of Examination

Registration for the examination shall be done through UUCMS / MU Linx portal on notification sent from the University

4. Malpractice

Any candidate found or caught indulging in or abetting malpractice during the Examination shall be debarred from writing the examination in that paper.

B. DECLARATION OF RESULTS

Results of Internal Examination will be announced within a week after the final exam. Answers will be discussed with students in person.

Results of University Examination will be announced based on the completion of the centralized evaluation.

Classification of Candidates

a) Degree Certificates will be awarded only to those candidates who pass in all the courses of the Programme.

b) A candidate who passes the entire programme in single attempt is eligible for the award of rank.
